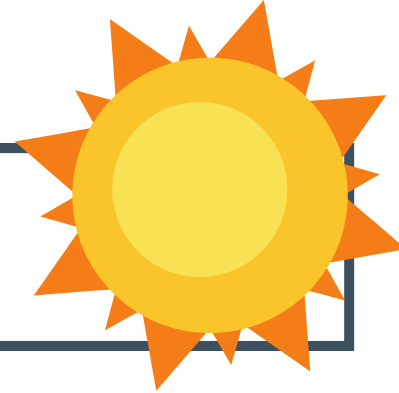

PSALM 125

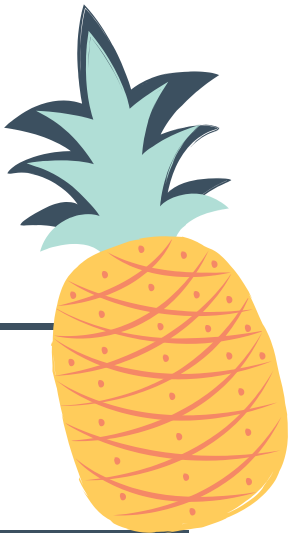
Those who trust in the Lord are like Mount Zion,

Peace be upon Israel!

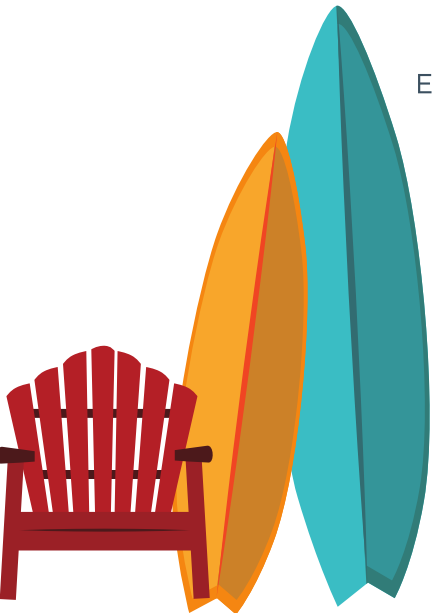

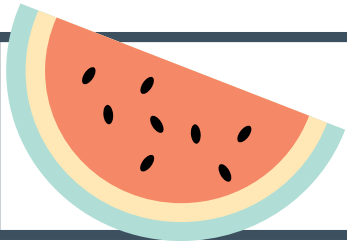
